

SKI VISIT TO JAY PEAK, VERMONT, USA, SUNDAY 6 APRIL - SUNDAY 13 APRIL 2025

Thank you for your continued support of the Ski visit to Jay Peak in 2025. As our departure nears, you will receive more updates, so please be sure to check your emails regularly. We also kindly ask that you continue making payments according to the schedule, as meeting all deadlines is crucial. Organising a trip to the USA is a complex undertaking, and delays in payments, paperwork, or other information make the process significantly more challenging.

We will be holding a meeting for parents and participating students on Wednesday, 15 January 2025, at 6.00pm. in the school hall. During this meeting, we will provide further details about the trip and offer a chance for questions. In the meantime, please complete the ESTA and Ski Provider Forms using the link provided. I have also included some additional information that may be helpful.

Travel documentation

Passport: Please ask your son/daughter to bring his/her passport to the school Finance office so that we can take a copy. If your son/daughter does not hold a valid passport, or it is due to expire this month, please apply **immediately**. Our provider suggests that there should be 6 months validity remaining on the passport after 13 April. You may use the old passport information on the forms, but this will need to be updated as soon as a new passport is available.

ESTA: Please also be aware that you will need to apply for ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization) for which your son/daughter will need a valid passport. To apply, go to <u>https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov</u>. This is the official US Homeland Security website, and the fee is 21 US dollars. Other sites may charge more. You will need the following hotel information to apply for the ESTA:

Skiwear: this will be discussed at the parents' meeting in January, but we suggest that you borrow or buy secondhand skiwear if possible, or put it on your child's birthday/Christmas gift list. Many people buy from Vinted or other secondhand clothing outlets.

Please note: skis, boots, poles and helmets are provided at the resort

Items that participants will need:

- Ski jacket and trousers/salopettes they need to be warm and waterproof
- Base layers thermal
- Ski socks x 3 pairs (ski specific) calf length can be turned inside out on the second day
- Ski goggles anti fog essential
- Ski gloves/mittens
- Balaclava/face mask optional
- Hoodie/fleece and bobble hat
- Sunblock and lip balm
- Water bottle (empty for airport security)
- Small backpack for travel and daytime use
- Footwear: Trainers are essential. We also suggest a spare pair of something comfortable. We do not recommend snow boots as the resort keeps the paths and roads clear. If you have a pair of walking boots, or snowshoes you could bring them, but please don't buy them just for this trip.
